St. Joseph, Guardian and Guide of Husbands, Father of Fathers

In today's gospel reading from the beginning of St. Matthew, he tells us of how the birth of Jesus came about, of how his mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph her husband, of how she was found with child through the Holy Spirit, of how Joseph resolved to end his betrothal with Mary.

Catholic tradition proposes three main interpretations to explain Joseph's dilemma. Given what St. Matthew has written it is possible to see the reasoning in each interpretation. There are saintly doctors of the Church who hold to each tradition.

The tradition that is most beautiful takes into account St. Joseph's holiness, his reverence, his personal love and compassion for Mary, and his awareness of her vulnerability, holding that he knew the miraculous cause of Mary's pregnancy from very early on. Mary would have told him of the event of the Annunciation, probably before she left to visit Elizabeth. St. Luke tells us that she left in *haste*; he doesn't say that she left *immediately*. Her immediate concern was for Joseph her husband. That we know nothing of their conversation provides us with the greatest model of intimacy in marriage given by the holiest husband and wife.

But still, the event of the Annunciation plunged Joseph into confusion. What could be his place in what was unfolding? As a *just man* could he give his name to a child who wasn't his?

In a wonderful book, *Life of Jesus*, written by Fr. Francisco Fernandez-Carvajal, a Spanish Roman Catholic priest, the author tells us that everything Joseph knew of Mary, "through their intimate conversations, the grace reflected in her face, her happiness," would not have allowed for him to think negatively of her. "The look in her eyes was clear, pure and serene as always...her countenance was even more radiant than in the months before".

Fr. Fernandez continues, "We cannot forget that Joseph was in all likelihood the person who, after Mary, received the most graces from God...He was a man chosen and prepared by the Blessed Trinity to care for the people most loved by God here on earth: Jesus and Mary. God paid special attention in choosing him and forming him interiorly for the entirely unique situation". His mission was to care for the household of God.

Fr. Fernandez makes the point that the *just man* in union with God doesn't flounder when things become complicated, or when he does not understand, or when faced with God's silence. In his deep faith and with profound reasoning Joseph considered and waited prayerfully in the silence of Nazareth.

Joseph's love for Mary was transcendent, as was his mercy. Fr. Fernandez writes that Joseph decided to protect Mary with secrecy, putting her away quietly so that nothing unworthy could be attributed to her; he would not allow her to be exposed to shame.

Convinced of Mary's virtue Joseph would be the witness and guardian of it. Fr. Fernandez writes that Joseph's idea was "to move away, leaving the betrothal promises unfulfilled. Mary would become an abandoned woman suffering misfortune caused by another's offense....He would be the culprit...He would go away even though it broke his heart..."

And then the angel in a dream!

In *Fire of Mercy,* a beautiful four-volume meditation on the Gospel of St. Matthew begun in 1996 and completed 25 years later in 2021, Erasmo Leiva-Merikakis who is now Trappist Fr. Simeon of St. Jospeh Abbey in Spencer writes that Joseph "is called upon to love his wife in virginity, to nurture another's Child, expecting no personal reward, to mobilize all his practical resourcefulness and thus cooperate in giving birth to God's plan of salvation. His vocation is to be the visible fatherhood of God on earth, to serve the Son of God and his Mother selflessly, and such service is reward enough in itself".

In these days we husbands and fathers are blessed to hear again within the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass Matthew's infancy narrative where he places Joseph before us. As we prayerfully reflect on Joseph's dilemma and the way in which he determined to solve it, the love we have for our own wives fills our hearts to overflowing. The overflow spills out to our own children, inspiring us to be fathers after the heart of Joseph. The overflow also spills into the world just as Joseph's love continues to do in his quiet, silent way.

What a gift this beginning of St. Matthew's Gospel is to the Church and to the world! What a gift is St. Joseph!

St. Joseph, pray for us.



John 3:16




Nativity Crèche






FIRST READING

When Joseph awoke, he did as the angel of the Lord had commanded him and took his wife into his home.




