

## **DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY**



### The Great Parable of Divine Mercy

In the letter to the Hebrews there is a wonderful verse that speaks of Scripture saying that "the word of God is living and effective, sharper than any two-edged sword, penetrating even between soul and spirit, joints and marrow, and able to discern reflections and thoughts of the heart." (Heb 4:12)

Whenever I hear or read that verse the great parable of the prodigal son comes immediately to mind. In the 15th chapter of his Gospel, St. Luke actually recounts three parables of divine mercy which Jesus told to the Pharisees and the scribes who were offended that tax collectors and sinners were so drawn to him.

It may have been that the Pharisees and scribes were unmoved by the parables of the lost sheep and the lost coin; we know these particular Pharisees and scribes for their hardness of heart. Jesus continued then to tell them the parable of the son who leaves his father's home.

Is it possible to be unmoved by the parable of the prodigal son? Isn't the parable of the prodigal son living and effective? Doesn't it penetrate even between soul and spirit, joints and marrow? It goes right to our hearts.

In the first volume of Jesus of Nazareth Pope Benedict XVI writes that it would be more accurate to title it the The Parable of the Two Brothers (the Prodigal Son and the Son Who Remained at Home) and the Good Father.

We know the parable well. "A man had two sons, and the younger son said to his father, 'Father, give me the share of your estate that should come to me.' So the father divided the property between them. . . ." The father gives freedom. The son journeys to a distant country where he squanders his inheritance on a life of dissipation. This son sinks low.

Pope Benedict notes that the Greek word used for property means "essence" in the vocabulary of Greek philosophy; the son squanders "his essence," himself. He becomes totally enslaved. Far away from his father's home he lost true freedom; he lost himself. In his anguish he realizes this and has a change of heart. He came to himself; he came to be who he truly is. He decides to return to his father.

The father saw the son from far off, ran to him, embraced him and kissed him. "His son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you; I no longer deserve to be called your son.' "His son had found the way to true freedom; he had risen from the dead. The father ordered a feast and celebration, an image of the Eucharist.

The father also went out to meet the son who had remained at home and was bitter at his father's forgiveness. "He said to him, 'My son, you are here with me always; everything I have is yours. But now we must celebrate and rejoice, because your brother was dead and has come to life again; he was lost and has been found."

Who but God could have told such a story? Doesn't it penetrate our heart? Such is Divine Mercy.

We think of the times we have been prodigal. We think of our jealous bitterness in times of joyful forgiveness. And thankfully through the divine life given to us in the sacraments we also have the grace to be like the Father. Such is Divine Mercy.

St. Luke is the only evangelist who recounts the parable of the prodigal son. He addresses his Gospel to Theophilus, which means friend of God; we know that we are. To St. Luke we owe a debt of gratitude.

St. Luke, pray for us.

Pope St. John Paul II, pray for us. St. Faustina, pray for us.

Jesus, I trust in you.



Thomas, called Didymus, one of the Twelve, was not with them when Jesus came. So the other disciples said to him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them, "Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands and put my finger into the nail marks and put my hand into his side, I will not believe."

Now a week later his disciples were again inside and Thomas was with them. Jesus came, although the doors were locked, and stood in their midst and said, "Peace be with you." Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here and see my hands, and bring your hand and put it into my side, and do not be unbelieving, but believe." Thomas answered and said to him, "My Lord and my God!" Jesus said to him, "Have you come to believe because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed."

Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of his disciples that are not written in this book. But these are written that you may come to believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that through this belief you may have life in his name.


St. Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle, be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil.
