LOOKING FORWARD

The previous two bulletin entries have been excerpts from Pope St. John Paul II's 1994 *Letter to Families*. The reason for this is that, as I've written before, we are beginning the process of forming our vision for what the parishes and school will be once we seriously pass out of this time of constraint. Our families are central to this vision, so now is the time to think about our purpose as a Catholic community, what defines us, and what direction our parish and school life takes. One aspect of the timing of our planning is natural: the parishes developed a "collaborative plan" several years ago that needs to be revisited, which conveniently coincides with the development of a new strategic plan for the school. Since one goal of our school life is to have greater integration with parish life, the plans and, more importantly, the nitty-gritty of how we operate must interrelate.

The other aspect of the timing of rethinking our community life gets back to that idea of being constrained. Many of our most faithful parishioners, typically older, had to endure the greatest constraint on their lives because of their vulnerability to the effects of the virus. Yet at the same time, in the midst of all this constraint, one could also notice those who went out of their way to bring their families to Mass, commit to in-person formation whether in the school or religious education, or seek to start their family within our parish environment when it would have been easier to just not bother.

As future months come and go, we will be keeping an eye on how (or whether) our Mass attendance improves. I predict that much ink and audio will be spent on how to "bring people back." In fact, the universal Church is entering into a "listening process" to make sure we can better hear those who may not feel sufficiently acknowledged by Her. Both are good concerns, but it makes me wonder if our vision is currently blind to those right before us: families and individuals striving to nourish their faith life in a world that may not want to hear the Faith, let alone support it.

Next week we will begin Lent, and our focus as disciples will necessarily shift to our individual reflection, prayer, and even purification in order to be more faithful disciples of Christ. This process will also occur as a community: reflecting and redirecting aspects of our collaborative life so that we are best prepared to accompany individuals and families into an ever deepening relationship with Our Lord. May our Lenten efforts both on an individual and collaborative level bear great fruit for the kingdom of God.



FAST & ABSTINENCE

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection.

LENT

Lent is a 40 day season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving that begins on Ash Wednesday and ends at sundown on Holy Thursday. It's a period of preparation to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection at Easter. During Lent, we seek the Lord in prayer by reading Sacred Scripture; we serve by giving alms; and we practice self-control through fasting. We are called not only to abstain from luxuries during Lent, but to a true inner conversion of heart as we seek to follow Christ's will more faithfully. We recall the waters of baptism in which we were also baptized into Christ's death, died to sin and evil, and began new life in Christ.






