From Fr. Joe

Jesus prays: “Consecrate them in the truth. Your word is truth. As you sent me into the world, so I sent them into the world. And I consecrate myself for them, so that they also may be consecrated in truth.” To consecrate means to set apart for a holy purpose.

Only freedom which submits to the Truth leads the human person to the true good. The good of the human person is to be *in* the Truth and to *do* the Truth. Our present-day culture has lost sight of this essential bond between the truth, the good, and freedom. As a result, helping mankind to rediscover this bond is a major priority in the Church’s mission for the salvation of the world. It is the Church’s job to help mankind understand the basic truth about human nature. Our nature is a created nature. It is ultimately subject to something bigger than itself, namely the Creator Who is God. God created us and gave us the gift of freedom, but it is a freedom given in order for us to seek the truth. Mankind fails to understand the meaning of freedom so God sends His only Son to show us.

The crucified Christ reveals the authentic meaning of freedom; he lives it fully in the total gift of himself and calls his disciples to share in his freedom. Freedom is rooted in the truth about mankind and it is ultimately directed toward communion, toward love. Total self-gift is a key point. Jesus made a total gift of Himself to mankind when opened His arms on the Cross. He shows the full meaning of human freedom just at the point when He surrenders

even the freedom of movement.

What is the full meaning of human freedom? **The gift of self in service to God and neighbor.** In communion with our Crucified and Risen Lord, the Church lives in freedom, making a total gift of herself and serving all of mankind. As members of the Church, we are consecrated in truth, set apart for a holy purpose. We make a total gift of ourselves in the vocation to which God calls us. Some of us are called to total self-gift in marriage and the raising of children. Others are called to total self-gift in the priesthood or the consecrated, religious life where we nurture spiritual children rather than biological children. Still others choose neither and remain in a chaste, single state, thus having more “freedom” to pursue a greater excellence in the world and support the other two groups in their tasks. God gives the gift of freedom to all of us in order that we might live the truth of the human good in self-sacrificing love, in the service of God and our neighbor. And our model in doing all of this is Our Lord and Savior, Jesus the Christ.

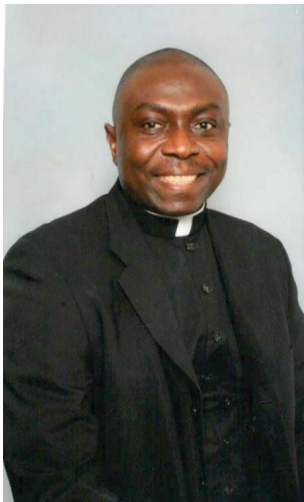
Jesus is the living summation of perfect freedom in total obedience to the will of God. His crucified flesh fully reveals the unbreakable bond between freedom and truth. His Resurrection from the dead is the supreme exaltation of the fruitfulness of freedom lived out in truth. And His Ascension raises all humanity to the truth about its real destiny to be with God forever.

As one example, prayer is one of many great acts of service to God and neighbor. God has given us the

freedom to pursue the good of self-gift to God and one another. Our nation doesn’t openly punish us for exercising that freedom, at least not yet. So by all means, take advantage of that freedom. Worship and love God through prayer and action in daily life.

As we approach the Altar of Our Lord’s Holy Sacrifice, please pray for me and for all priests. Pray for more vocations to priesthood and the consecrated life and for more men and women to say yes to that vocation. Pray for the men who will be ordained this coming Saturday the 22nd for this Archdiocese. Pray for and support good, holy, and fruitful marriages. Pray for those who remain single that they may live chaste, happy, and fruitful lives of service for the sake of the Kingdom. Pray in reparation for sins and sacrileges committed against Our Lady and Our Lord, especially in the Most Blessed Sacrament. Have a loving and honest conversation with God everyday. Pray the Rosary and Divine Mercy Chaplet for the sick, the dying, and the Holy Souls.

Pray! Pray! Pray! Prayer is conversation with God and no relationship can survive without conversation. Thank God for His love and mercy and tell Him that you love Him. We pray as Jesus prayed: “Consecrate them in the truth. Your word is truth. As you sent me into the world, so I send them into the world. And I consecrate myself for them, so that they also may be consecrated in truth.” Jesus consecrates us, sets us apart for a holy purpose, from the altar of the Holy Sacrifice as from the Altar of the Cross.

On Tuesday, May 11, the members of the Sodality visited the women living at Haven of Hope in Methuen for their

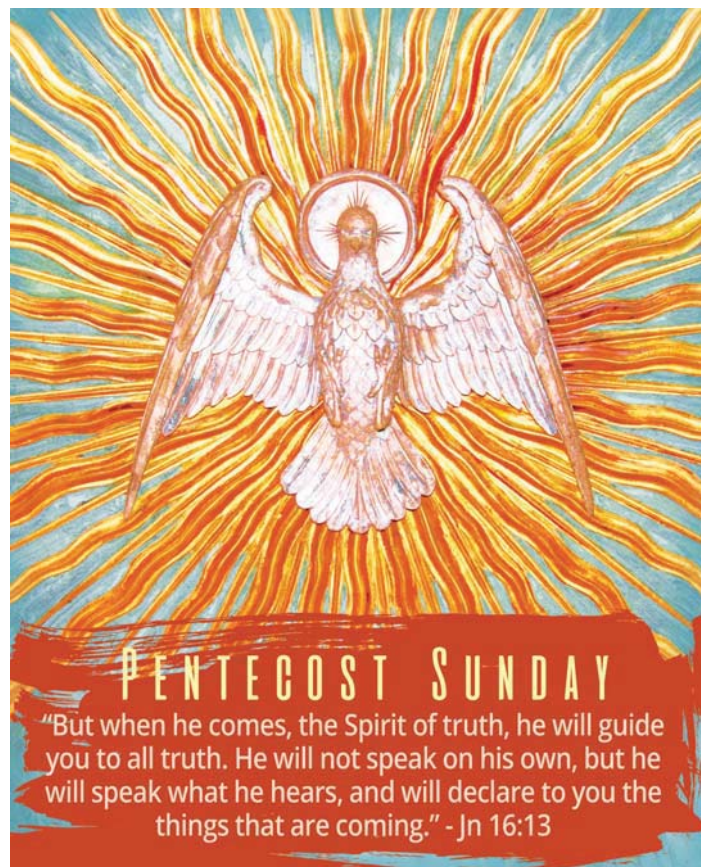
Annual Handbag Project.
