GODPARENT FORM

- If a godparent is married, he or she must have received the Sacrament of Matrimony;
- Only one godparent is required, however, if two godparents are chosen, one must be male and one female.

If you find this to be the case, our pastoral team would love to connect with you, to discern what steps we can take to help you prepare to make your sacraments before taking on this crucial ministry!
