



Although the Easter Season lasts for 50 days concluding on the feast of Pentecost, the Octave of Easter (the 8 days of Easter) conclude today on the Feast of Divine Mercy.

Space does not permit the entire miraculous narrative to be explained here, but please do take the time to delve into the history of Divine Mercy and you will see how Divine Providence unfurled to allow this devotion of mercy to flourish.

To one simple, uneducated Polish nun back in the 1930's, just before WWII, the devotion was predicted by Jesus to spread, but would be suppressed, and then eventually flourish because of a wise, educated Polish man, Pope St. John Paul II.

Therefore we now have the Novena to Divine Mercy which can be prayed starting on Good Friday to prepare us for Divine Mercy Sunday. Jesus said to St. Faustina about praying this Novena, "I will grant every possible grace to souls."

It is of the Feast of Mercy that Jesus desired to "be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially poor sinners. Whoever approaches the Fount of Life on this day will be granted complete remission of sins and punishment. On that day are open all the divine floodgates through which graces flow."

To benefit one must put his trust in God, carry out acts of mercy, be in the state of sanctifying grace, receive Holy Communion and venerate the image of Divine Mercy. You will notice the two rays emanating out from Jesus' Sacred Heart. The white ray symbolizes the Most Holy Sacrament which most fully nourishes the soul. Jesus said, "The soul that venerates this image shall not perish." However, in a later visit to St. Faustina, Jesus said the image "is to be a reminder of the demands of My mercy, for even the strongest faith is of no avail without works."

Join us this Divine Mercy Sunday at 2:00pm in the Gethsemane Chapel where Deacon John Pierce and Deacon John Kobrenski (another fine Polish individual) will lead us in this grace-filled devotion, as well as adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Priests will be available for confession.

Jesus revealed to St. Faustina that, "Mankind will not have peace until it turns with trust to My mercy." He said, "The graces from My mercy are drawn by one vessel, and that vessel is trustfulness."

Praying the Litany of Trust will help one and all to truly live out the motto of Divine Mercy:

"Jesus, I trust in You!"


FIRST READING

SECOND READING

Rev 1: 9-11a, 12-13, 17-19

I, John, your brother, who share with you the distress, the kingdom, and the endurance we have in Jesus, found myself on the island called Patmos because I proclaimed God's word and gave testimony to Jesus. I was caught up in spirit on the Lord's day and heard behind me a voice as loud as a trumpet, which said, "Write on a scroll what you see." Then I turned to see whose voice it was that spoke to me, and when I turned, I saw seven gold lampstands and in the midst of the lampstands one like a son of man, wearing an ankle-length robe, with a gold sash around his chest. When I caught sight of him, I fell down at his feet as though dead. He touched me with his right hand and said, "Do not be afraid. I am the first and the last, the one who lives. Once I was dead, but now I am alive forever and ever. I hold the keys to death and the netherworld. Write down, therefore, what you have seen, and what is happening, and what will happen afterwards."

GOSPEL Jn 20: 19-31

On the evening of that first day of the week, when the doors were locked, where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you." When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. The disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained." Thomas, called Didymus, one of the Twelve, was not with them when Jesus came. So the other disciples said to him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them, "Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands and put my finger into the nailmarks and put my hand into his side, I will not believe." Now a week later his disciples were again inside and Thomas was with them. Jesus came, although the doors were locked, and stood in their midst and said, "Peace be with you." Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here and see my hands, and bring your hand and put it into my side, and do not be unbelieving, but believe." Thomas answered and said to him, "My Lord and my God!" Jesus said to him, "Have you come to believe because you have seen me!" Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed." Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of his disciples that are not written in this book. But these are written that you may come to believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that through this belief you may have life in his name.






