

ALLELUIA! HE IS RISEN!

NEW LIFE AT EASTER

Every great day of celebration throughout the year brings its own cultural expressions. Think of the various holidays that we anticipate and the pattern of preparation and recreation around the three day weekends that go with them. Easter, although it is the greatest celebration in the Church calendar, doesn't come with a secular holiday, probably because it is always celebrated on a Sunday, and now goes often unnoticed in our society. However, today does seem to still be the most identified by the kind of food people eat during this holy time. Yes, the November turkey is pretty universal, but I'm going to contend that when we think of Thanksgiving, many more thoughts enter our consciousness around the purpose of that long holiday than its associated food, which is consumed year-round.

The Easter basket, Easter Egg, and perhaps brunch *defines* Easter for most people today, with little thought of why it is marked. In many of our ethnic traditions, several foods come only with Easter. That's because historically the Great Fast of Lent meant abstaining from meat, dairy, eggs, and all kinds of dessert items that make their dramatic return in a cornucopia on the day of the Resurrection. The egg and the season of Spring mark new life and change, but they are merely happy symbols associated with the conquering of death and eternal transformation that Christ won for us by his Resurrection.

In a great and ancient Holy Saturday homily we hear Christ speaking to Adam as He descends to the dead to rescue humanity waiting for the opening of Heaven:

"Out of love for you and for your descendants I now by my own authority command all who are held in bondage to come forth, all who are in darkness to be enlightened, all who are sleeping to arise. Rise up, work of my hands, you who were created in my image. I did not create you to be a prisoner in hell. Rise, let us leave this place, for you are in me and I am in you. The enemy led you out of the earthly paradise, but I will enthrone you in Heaven. I forbade you a tree that was only a symbol of life, but see, I who am life itself, am now one with you. The kingdom of Heaven has been prepared for you from all eternity." That's a lot to think about when you're eating an Easter Egg!

Spring brings a welcome change to the weather, though most people don't like change in their daily habits. My prayer is that the changes coming to our parishes and school this season bring new life and new members to our community of faith. We all pray on this holiest of Sundays that our families will grow in the transformation of Christ and the peace that He offers. Finally, regarding the food that marks our gatherings: maybe it can be an opportunity to remind a loved one who has forgotten the gift of new life offered by the Resurrected Christ, the purpose of the day we celebrate.
