

And the results are in.....

I would like to thank all of you who voted for new members of the Collaborative Pastoral Council. You may remember that each parish had a slate of six individuals, with each parishioner voting to select two. Potential members were nominated by the current members of the Council, and then each nominee was called or approached personally to confirm that they would be willing to serve. So I would, also, like to thank those folks who became the nominees by being willing to serve on the Council.

Not unexpectedly, I did receive some feedback as to why nominations were not solicited from the whole parish. My response is that we should probably find a way next round for that to be the case, but let me add a few qualifiers to that. First, to my understanding, this is the first "general election" since the beginning of the Collaborative. At that time, current Council members from both parishes were randomly assigned extended terms of service with the intent of initiating a new selection process in the future. Obviously, that never happened. In fact, one member of the current Council has been on for 20 years! So this year is definitely a step forward in developing a succession process.

Second, the Collaborative Pastoral Council is not a legislative body, it is an advisory body to the Pastor. Any process that allows a person to campaign for a spot, particularly with an agenda, is foreign to the process. This is the reason why the current members suggested names and discussed as a group those who would be good potential members. Lastly, there is no set method to determine the membership of the Council. In many parishes it is by appointment or other method that reduces the chances, again, of a political campaign for something that really is a form of service to the Collaborative.

So what are the results? Basically, I've decided to have all the nominees on both ballots serve on the Council. Based on voting, some will receive 3-year terms, others 2-years, and others a 1-year term. This allows us to reinstate that sense of a rolling succession process provided that we have elections each year, though I suspect next year the process and the size of the slate will be a little different than this year. I am very grateful to the current Collaborative Council for their service, which has not been a simple time for any of us, and thankful that they are willing to step back from membership at this time to welcome the new members. I have asked two current members to remain for continuity: Mary-Jo Farelli from St. Monica, who is also the President of St. Vincent de Paul Society, and Larry Giordano, from St. Lucy, who has been on the Council for only 1-year.

Congratulations to our new members (in alphabetical order by length of term)!

Three-Year Terms: Monica Silvey, Mark Ward, John Waterworth, and Ellen Wholley.

Two-Year Terms: Nino Amoroso, Mary Camuso, Trish Rafferty, and Henry Therberge.

One-Year Terms: Kerin McLaughlin, John Santarpio, Jane Shawcross, and Joseph Serwatka.






