

DEACON JOHN KOBRENSKI

"... Ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you." We hear these words in the Gospel today, but just what do they mean? Do we get whatever we ask for? Or do we always find what we are looking for? Do we always find the door open to our ambitions and dreams?

The answer is quite simple. No, we don't. But why? Jesus promised us that we could ask and receive. But very often, we are like children who don't know what we're asking for.

Saint Augustine writes: "Pray for temporal goods...and rest in the knowledge that they come to us from him who knows what is best for us. Did you ask and not get what you wanted? Trust in your Father. If it would have been good for you, you would have received it. Before God, you are much as a little child is before you. All day long, the child cries his eyes out so that you will give him a knife to play with. You wisely refuse his plea and pay no attention to his wailing. When your child demands to ride a horse, you won't let him. The child doesn't know how to ride and may get injured or even killed as a result. You deny him in little things so as to preserve more important things. You want the child to grow up safely and possess all his own goods without danger."

After telling us that we can ask and receive, Jesus goes on the say, "What father among you would hand his son a snake when he asks for a fish? Or hand him a scorpion when he asks for an egg?" He will never replace what we ask for with something that would harm us. And unfortunately, even though we can't see it at the time, we ask for lots of things that aren't good for us.

In Luke's version of the Lord's Prayer at the beginning of this Gospel, Jesus teaches us to ask for our daily bread; he'll give us what we need. God always knows our needs better than we do. And since he loves us, we should always accept that whatever happens to us is his will and, therefore, a sign of love.

But Jesus also tells us that we should continue to make our requests even when it seems that they are not being answered in the way we desired. When the friend asks for three loaves of bread in the Gospel reading and is refused because the person, he is asking is already in bed with the doors locked, Jesus says, "I tell you, if he does not get up to give the visitor the loaves because of their friendship, he will get up to give him whatever he needs because of his persistence." Notice the reference to whatever the friend needs, not necessarily to what he is asking for. Keep asking. God will always give us what we need, even if it takes many prayers and many years. God loves us and will always do what is best for us in his eternal plan for our good.

"If you then, who are wicked, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask?" God is all good. Any good that we do, He can outdo to an infinite degree. He looks upon each of us with an infinite love and has planned our eternal happiness before the world was even created. He is a good Father and will answer every one of our prayers some way, if not with what we want, then surely give us what we need, the Holy Spirit.





In those days, the LORD said: "The outcry against Sodom and Gomorrah is so great, and their sin so grave, that I must go down and see whether or not their actions fully correspond to the cry against them that comes to me. I mean to find out."

While Abraham's visitors walked on farther toward Sodom, the LORD remained standing before Abraham. Then Abraham drew nearer and said: "Will you sweep away the innocent with the guilty? 


