

SUNDAY OF EASTER

A New Pentecost

Dear Parishioners,

In the first few months in Methuen, I spoke about the need to evangelize. Technically speaking, evangelizing is announcing the Good News of the Gospel to those who know nothing about Jesus, but in its broadest sense, it also means announcing God's Good News to all who need Jesus, especially those who, for one reason or another, have strayed from their practice of the Catholic faith. During this moment of the history of the Church, we are called to a New Evangelization, but for that we need also a new Pentecost, you and I need to be continuously transformed by the power of the Holy Spirit.

In the months of November, December, and January, I set a goal of recruiting members for the evangelization committee; currently, the committee is made up of about fifteen people. From February to the present, we have met once a month with the evangelization committee for training. Looking to the future, this is the plan we want to follow:

One Plus One Mission (June-September). With the word "mission" I mean the very task of reaching out to people who need God to invite them to meet Jesus. The Evangelization Committee aims to invite those who have strayed from the faith to an experience of encounter with Christ through the Christ Life Program. The goal of this mission is for each of us to invite one person to join the program and, therefore, to join the parish community of our collaborative.

Christ Life Program: Discovering Christ (September-November). At the end of September, the evangelization committee we will run this program, which will teach a series of topics to help attendees have a personal encounter with Christ or renew their encounter if they have had one. The program consists of a dinner in small groups, a video lesson, and a moment of reflection on the topic received. The program lasts seven weeks and will take place on Tuesdays from 6:30 pm to 8 pm in the Parish Hall of St. Lucy's. During springtime we will run the second part of the program and later the third one.

The One Plus One Mission will be the instrument to reach out to those we want to invite to the program. This mission has a very simple methodology, and it consists largely of praying for half an hour every day to thank God for making us part of this task, for those carrying out this mission, and for all those who will be invited to the Christ Life program, along with the personal invitation we must make. This is the program that the missionaries will follow:

FIRST MONTH (Sunday, June 1st to Saturday, June 28th): Prayer of praise and thanksgiving to God. Each missionary will pray for half an hour daily to give thanks to God for the gift of faith, the church, and being part of the mission of the salvation of the world.

SECOND MONTH (Sunday, June 29th to Saturday, July 26th): Prayer for the mission and the missionaries. During this second moth we will continue with our prayer, but the intention will be to pray for those who will carry out the mission. Asking the Lord to empower us and with His gifts.

THIRD MONTH (Sunday, July 27th to Saturday, August 30th and after): Prayer for those who will receive the mission and reaching out to them.

I am writing to you about this project for two reasons: firstly, to let you know what the collaborative is doing. We are a community of faith, a community of brothers and sisters, so we must be all aware of the good things we are doing. Secondly, to request your support. During this summertime, please remember to pray for this project of Evangelization. Later in the summer we will publicize the Christ Life program, and we will ask you to invite people to it. Right know is time to pray as the apostles did in the upper room, is time to pray and ask God to send forth the Holy Spirit like He did at Pentecost so we can also do what the apostles did: announce the Love of God to all who are in need.



May that same grace spread the joy and peace of our Redeemer throughout the earth. To you our God, eternally blessed, be glory and praise for ever. Amen.


Saints Marcellinus and Peter

arcellinus was a priest and Peter an exorcist in Rome's Christian community. They were arrested and imprisoned during a persecution by Emperor Diocletian. In prison, they converted many people, including their jailer and his family. They were condemned to death and beheaded, supposedly in secret, in a nearby wood. But their executioner disclosed the deaths after his conversion. Pope St. Damasus I wrote an epitaph for their tomb, over which Emperor Constantine later built a church in which he buried his mother. This pope also reported that he learned the details of their martyrdom from the executioner himself. Marcellinus and Peter are among the saints named in the Roman Canon of the Mass.






