

Today is the Feast of Christ the King, the last Sunday of the liturgical year. Its official name is the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe and it is celebrated in honor of Our Lord Jesus Christ as Lord of all creation (the physical world, and the spiritual world, as well).

Scientists estimate that the physical universe has a diameter of about 93 billion light years. A light year is about 6 trillion miles. Multiply 6 trillion by 93 billion and you'll find the size of the universe in miles, an almost unbelievably large number. Some scientists say that it is much bigger and that what we know as the universe is only a small portion of what it really is.

But Jesus is the Lord and King of it all. He is the reason for its existence. The Gospel of John records that, "All things were made through him. All things were made for him. And without him, nothing was made."

The creation account in the Book of Genesis states that, "God saw all that he had made, and it was very good." The universe is a very good creation and Christ is the King of it all. The amount of praise and honor that is his due, we cannot even imagine, but let us do the best we can with our weak human abilities. Let us always keep in mind how great and powerful he is and how good all of creation is, by honoring him at every moment, by respecting our world and other peoples, and by living our lives in imitation of Christ. Let us love him as he loves us.

Next Sunday is the First Sunday of Advent and the beginning of a new liturgical year. Advent is a time of preparation for the Feast of Christmas, the celebration of the birth of Our Lord Jesus Christ in Bethlehem. How do we prepare for that?

First, by trying to better grasp what it really means for Christ to become a human being and be born in a stable and laid in a manger. "And the word was made flesh and dwelt among us." The word of God, the second person of the Trinity, left his throne in heaven and became one of us. God became man. We cannot imagine how much lower we are than God, but he humbled himself and became lower than the angels and lived on earth with us. That is the love that he has for mankind.

He made himself a little lower than the angels, and by doing so, raised us up to a dignity even higher than the angels. Jesus became one with us so that we could become one with God. That we can become one with God is something that is almost unbelievable but is what Christ has accomplished by becoming one with us.

The second way to prepare for Advent is by realizing why Christ became one of us. Only he was worthy to make the sacrifice necessary for the forgiveness of all our sins. Only he could show us the proper way to live. He humbled himself to become man and to show us how to live by imitating him. He was meek and humble of heart, and we should try to imitate his meekness and humility. That is not an easy thing to do. It takes work and dedication, but that is one of the things that Advent is all about. He was also poor, and he suffered much on earth for our sake. Let us follow his example and treat the poor with the respect they deserve as our brothers and sisters. And let us comfort the suffering in any way that we can.

At the same time, Advent is a time of joy as Christmas comes closer and closer. It is a time of rejoicing for most of us. But we all know others for whom it is not a happy season. Some grow depressed during this time of year. Let us pray for them and for their happiness and let us practice becoming more and more like Jesus during this Advent season. And let us become more and more enthusiastic, knowing that he is ever nearer as we strive to become even closer to him. Peace and all good things,

NO FAITH FORMATION


