"But it shall not be so among you. Rather, whoever wishes to be great among you will be your servant; whoever wishes to be first among you will be the slave of all. For the Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many." - Mk 10:43-45

FROM THE DESK OF FR. JOE:

The rich young man went away sad (Mark 10:22). We are familiar with this account from last Sunday's Gospel. Jesus speaking to a faithful Jew of His day appealed first to the Commandments. If a Catholic of our day bumped into Our Blessed Lord and asked the same question, Jesus' response might be a little different. Jesus might say, "You know what it means to be a Roman Catholic. Go to Mass faithfully every Sunday and every Holy Day of Obligation. Go to Confession regularly. Give to your local parish; support the mission of the Church in the world. Take care of your family, your parents, and your neighbors. Participate in the life of your local community that it may be imbued with your Holy Catholic values, that the Gospel might reach the local community and the world by your good and holy works."

"Lord," said Catholic might respond, "all of these things I have been doing since my youth according to my state in life and the means I had at my disposal."

With a look of love, Our Lord's response might be, "Truly, you are anxious to know if you've done enough, if you're doing enough. Perhaps this anxiety is telling of itself. Remember that beautiful account about my friends Martha and Mary (Luke 10:38-42). Martha worried and fretted, suffered anxiety, over many things. Mary on the other hand chose first to learn My wisdom. Then all of the other things you try to do to build up the Kingdom will have My stamp on them first and foremost. If you put me first in all things, I will use you in ways you can't possibly imagine. Remember my little one, Saint Mother Theresa of Calcutta. Her consecrated daughters first spent hours each day with Me in the Most Blessed Eucharist. I can then act in their person to extend my merciful hand to those who are destitute. People need more than food and water; that only sustains the body in this life. People truly need food that sustains to Eternal Life. That's food only I can give, because I am the Bread of Life. I offer My Body and Blood to our Heavenly Father for the life of the world. While people may be "anxious" and "busy" about doing the work of the Gospel, first trust Me enough to spend time with me in the Sacraments and in prayer that is not distracted by driving or whatever. Give Me the best time of your day and I will use you to bring true peace to the world, peace found in My Kingdom on earth and eternally in Heaven. You say it in the great prayer I taught you when I was with you 2000 years ago. You say: 'Thy Kingdom come, Thy Will be done, on earth as it is in Heaven.' Do you pray it? Do you know what I taught you to ask for? And do you mean it? I want to establish My Kingdom on earth. I want the Will of My Father done on earth as it is in Heaven. That is peace only I can give. Remember what I said: 'Peace I leave you, my peace I give you' (John 14:27). Not as the world gives peace do I give it because the world and the adversary seek peace without God. There is no such thing. Remember what My Mother said at Fatima:

'You have seen hell where the souls of poor sinners go. To save them, God wishes to establish in the world devotion to my Immaculate Heart. If what I say to you is done, many souls will be saved and there will be peace. The war is going to end: but if people do not cease offending God, a worse one will break out during the Pontificate of Pius XI. When you see a night illumined by an unknown light, know that this is the great sign given you by God that he is about to punish the world for its crimes, by means of war, famine, and persecutions of the Church and of the Holy Father. To prevent this, I shall come to ask for the consecration of Russia to my Immaculate Heart, and the Communion of reparation on the First Saturdays. If my requests are heeded, Russia will be converted, and there will be peace; if not, she will spread her errors throughout the world, causing wars and persecutions of the Church. The good will be martyred; the Holy Father will have much to suffer; various nations will be annihilated. In the end, my Immaculate Heart will triumph. The Holy Father will consecrate Russia to me, and she shall be converted, and a period of peace will be granted to the world.'


Notice what My Mother prophesied at Fatima has occurred with a few exceptions at the end. Those exceptions have yet to be fulfilled and they will be. Note especially that a period of peace will be granted the world, a peace yet to come. I love you. I always love you. I offer Myself to our Heavenly Father for you from the altar at Holy Mass as from the Altar of the Cross. Never fear anything but have Holy Fear (Awe) of God. Trust in Me alone!"

To which said Catholic might respond, "Yeah, but..."

The above is an hypothetical conversation meant to inspire humility in us and trust in God. A period of peace will be granted the world, only God knows when. As faithful Catholics, we can help and hasten that process by our walk with and trust in the Lord. Pray, pray, pray every day as you can the Holy Rosary, the Divine Mercy Chaplet, for the sick, the suffering, the dying, the souls in Purgatory, and the conversion of sinners in the culture. Our prayers make a difference; our sufferings that we offer with the Lord make a difference.

From the altar at Holy Catholic Mass as from the Altar of the Cross, Thy Kingdom come, Thy Will be done on earth as it is in Heaven. God bless you.
