Renew, Rebuild, and Reach Out: Disciples in Heartfelt Communion with Jesus Christ

After a first year of spiritual formation and discernment in responding to our call to serve the church as deacons, we begin academic studies in earnest. Our study of the New Testament begins with the Gospel of St. Mark. Of course, the Gospels are not only an intellectual endeavor, but a continuation of spiritual formation that never ends for both clergy and laity as we are all disciples sent to bring Christ into the world.

Mark tells us that Jesus called his disciples to be with him, to send them forth to preach, and to drive out demons. Hasn't he called us as well to be with him, and then to go from Mass to announce the Gospel, and through it to drive out demons?

In Ordinary Time during this liturgical year St. Mark's Gospel is foremost. It is a Gospel that speaks to us in these days because in it Jesus responds so immediately to the needs of others, even when he needs rest. Jesus moves obediently along the way to his cross, and his disciples are on the move with him. In the beginning they do not understand his destination, or that if they remain with him, they will go there as well. Doesn't that speak to us in these days?

Mark himself, though not an apostle, was a great disciple. It is fairly certain that he was the unnamed young man in the garden of Gethsemane who was nearly taken with

Jesus had he not slipped out of his linen cloth. He remained longer in the garden than any of the named disciples, but was it also an abandonment? Isn't it reassuring that we who have abandoned Our Lord so frequently are in such company as Peter and Mark?

Mark tells of Jesus through the eyes of St. Peter. In A. D. 150 St. Justin Martyr spoke of Mark's Gospel as the memoirs of Peter. In the first chapter Peter is called to follow Jesus and to be a fisher of men; in the last chapter after all that he had seen and heard he abandoned Jesus in his time of greatest need on Golgotha. Peter is presented as he saw himself; his honesty unrelenting and painful throughout.

In Peter we see a wonderful example of grace building on nature. As flawed as he was, he had great gifts. He was a natural leader, physically vigorous, with organizational skills developed in operating a business that fed so many.

He had done a great deal of preparation to be willing to take the risk of abandoning his nets to follow a man he seemed to recognize, but whom he had never seen. Peter would have been awed by the beauty of the created world surrounding the Sea of Galilee. He would have prayed the psalms and known scripture. He would have recognized his sins and grieved over them, but how could he be certain that he had been forgiven?

Peter recognized something in the Nazorean. He was given a gift by Our Father to recognize that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of the living God. In his freedom he did not have to accept the gift, but he did. And he said so. Though Peter saw himself as unworthy, Jesus would enter under his roof.

Peter agonized over his denials and abandonment in a grief beyond grief. Given all that he had received he saw himself as the greatest sinner. No wonder that he was given the keys to the kingdom. Who would he not go out to find and to carry back into the kingdom on earth? Haven't we seen that same burning desire in our Holy Fathers over the years of our lives?

To be able to pray with my wife in the *Scavi*, the excavation area many feet beneath the altar in St. Peter's Basilica where a small container holds Peter's bones, touched my heart then as it does now.

Mark's Gospel captured my imagination in the beginnings of my preparation as a deacon and my love for it has only grown over these twenty years.

St. Peter and St. Mark, such dear companions on the way, pray for us.

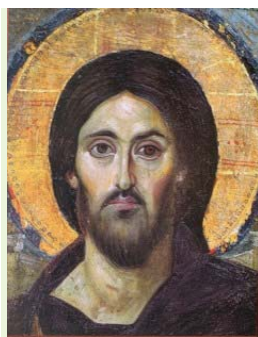
