the branches." In the gospel last week, we heard Jesus proclaim that he is the Good Shepherd who loves, guides, and protects his flock, even to the point of giving up his life to defend them. This week's gospel tells us that Jesus is even closer to us than that. His is the blood that flows through us and feeds our bodies. We are only alive because he is nourishing us. He is what gives us life.

If a branch falls off or is cut off from the vine, it simply will die. It no longer has the ability to bear fruit or even to live. Looking at this as a metaphor for the Church, we find that if we are separated from Christ, our life blood (our faith) is lost. Our spiritual life dries up, withers, and dies.

In his letter to the Corinthians. Paul compares the Church to the body, an image similar to the that of the vine and the branches. The body is composed of many parts and cells, but it is still only one body. We are not separate organs or cells. We are part of one functioning body. Any part that is cut off from the body will die, just as the branch that is removed from the vine will die. Again, looking at this as a metaphor for the Church, we see that we are all parts of the one body, the Church, and Christ is our head. This is why the Church is called the Mystical Body of Christ.

As Christians, we are all part of that Body, the Mystical Body of Christ. We each have our own function (mission) and are each equally valued and loved by our head (Christ). And we are all equally dependent on our Head (Christ) to lead us and to nourish us as we perform our mission(s). If we are separated from the

Mystical Body of Christ (the Church), we are losing the graces that give life to our souls. When that happens, our faith life withers and dies, and we are lost.

So, we should unite ourselves to the Church as the branch is to the vine and as the body is to its head. What does this mean in a practical sense? In The Word on Fire Bible (2020 by Word on Fire Catholic Ministries), Bishop Robert Barron writes: "It means a steady immersion in the prayer of the Church. It means steady communion with God, speaking to him (prayer) on a regular basis. It means an immersion in the Scriptures, soaking in the truth of the Bible. It means engaging in the corporal and spiritual works of mercy. And, of course, it means you must participate in the sacraments ---- especially Confession and the Eucharist. By the sacraments, we stay close to the Christ who forgives our sins and enlivens our spirits."

As a member of the Secular Franciscan Order. I've read much on the life of St. Francis of Assisi. One of his favorite sayings, even toward the end of his life, was: "Let us begin, for until now we have done nothing." There is always much more to do, no matter how much we have done in the past. Our work, as members of the Mystical Body of Christ, is never done. In these days of pandemic and social isolation. let us endeavor with more and more determination, to live in union with the Church and with Christ, our vine and the head of his Mystical Body. 'Let us begin, for until now we have done nothing." Peace and all good things!
