

## DUE TO THE SNOWSTORM LAST WEEK AND BECAUSE SO MANY OF YOU MISSED THE CELEBRATION OF EPIPHANY, FR. COLARUSSO'S MESSAGE IS BEING REPEATED.



The gifts brought by the Magi to the Holy Family have always been understood to have symbolic meaning due to the wise men's knowledge of prophecy and the Lord's identity: gold for a king, frankincense in worship of God, and myrrh for use in burial. How the gifts were used, though, is only the speculation of legend. One pious tale suggests that the gold was used to rent the stable, the frankincense to give it a pleasant fragrance, and the myrrh as a balm for the infant Jesus. That legend would go along with the fact that St. Joseph

and the Blessed Mother considered themselves still too poor to offer a lamb rather than a "pair of turtledoves" at his Presentation in the Temple. Or maybe they saved it knowing it was to be used with the intention of its symbolic meaning. We can't know these things.

One thing we do know is that it wasn't put into a trust to grow with interest and create an endowment to sustain a future project, like the Church. We in the Archdiocese of Boston never got to the point of building endowments either, at least not for most parishes. Certainly not ours. I know the archdiocese has trusts for clergy retirement (lucky for me and more lucky for those priests who started young), for seminary education, and to give scholarships for Catholic education for low-income families. However, the reality is that these trusts are underfunded and, in fact, the diocese may **owe** them money if it has borrowed from them at some point for other costs.

I say this because somebody gave me an observation after we launched our Grand Annual Appeal and consistent giving campaign. To paraphrase: "It may be true that those few people who still come to church consistently are already the dedicated people who have always supported the parish. But I bet if you asked them, 80% probably think that the Archdiocese supports the parish or has a big fund of money to bail you out if necessary." I was skeptical of this claim until I literally heard it from someone who fit the bill of a faithful Catholic who inquired as to why the diocese doesn't just give us more money if we are in deficit spending. The question did not surprise me, so much as now informs the content of this pastor entry.

So, for the record, there is no fund of money at the Archdiocese, no pot of gold, if you will, that we can draw from or ask for a gift. I'm not even sure if we could get a loan given that we are in deficit spending. The reality is that what you see as our savings listed in the end of year financial statement sent with the Grand Annual Appeal letter is all that we have for a cushion in these times of deficit. Please be attentive to the need for all of us to give consistently to the parish at a level truly proportional to our income and generously to the Grand Annual to make up the remaining deficit projected for this Fiscal Year.

FIRST READING

1 Samuel 3: 3b-10, 19

Samuel was sleeping in the temple of the LORD where the ark of God was. The LORD called to Samuel, who answered, "Here I am." Samuel ran to Eli and said, "Here I am. You called me." "I did not call you," eli said. "Go back to sleep." so he went back to sleep. Again the LORD called Samuel, who rose and went to Eli. "Here I am," he said. "You called me." But Eli answered, I did not call you, my son. go back to sleep."

At that time Samuel was not familiar with the LORD, because the LORD had not revealed anything to him as yet. The LORD called Samuel again, for the third time, Getting up and going to Eli, he said, "Here I am. You called me," Them Eli understood that the LORD was calling the youth. So he said to Samuel, "Go to sleep, and if you are called, reply, Speak, LORD, for your servant is listening." When Samuel went to sleep in his place, the LORD came and revealed his presence, calling out as before, "Samuel, Samuel!" Samuel answered, "Speak, for your servant is listening."

Samuel grew up, and the LORD was with him, not permitting any word of his to be without effect.


