

FROM FR. BILL MAY 27, 2018

Thank you to St. Monica and St. Lucy Parishes and St. Monica School

I wanted to take this last column that I write to you as pastor to say thank you for your kindnesses to me over the 4 ½ years with you and 3 as your pastor. It is a humbling feeling for priests to be accepted so lovingly by the people in our assignments. We come as complete strangers but a trust is placed upon us quickly as the people still have a natural desire to trust and love their priests. The priest has the privilege of having a window into the ups and downs of his peoples' lives. He is with them at times of great joy, baptisms and weddings, school celebrations, but also there for the hard times as well. Counseling people that may be suffering for a whole host of reasons, being with people who are dying and their families. Of all the pastoral services a priest provides, for me to be with families in the time leading up to death and the period that follows is most meaningful. Several young people who died young and quite suddenly come to my heart as do spouses and siblings of folks who are very involved in our parish life. Recently I had dinner with a middle-aged parishioner who lost his wife several years ago and he told me that before she died she told him she would be very happy if he married again. She expressed this desire to her adult children as well. The priest is seen as someone who brings his faith into very difficult situations to help people and though that is certainly true, so often the priest finds his own faith strengthened by the faith he finds already there so strong in the people. The love which that dying woman showed to her husband is breathtaking and no doubt she could show it not only because of the love God placed in her heart but because of the love she had received over many years from her husband.

To all of those whom I have accompanied at the bedside of a dying loved one I want you to know that above all you have the first place in my heart as I go. It is a privilege that words cannot capture to be there at those moments. To offer funeral masses for you is an honor and a privilege that I find most humbling. We have so many friends in heaven now, and I believe as more of those we love go to God it should make heaven seem closer than in the past. As I look out and see you at Mass your loved ones and those memories of being with you enter my heart.

As for the daily life of the parish there are simply too many people that I can't thank everyone in this space individually. A little girl who was just a tiny infant when I arrived and is now a four-year old little girl comes to mind. Each time I see her smiling face I am reminded of the time that has passed since I arrived. I think of lunches in the cafeteria with the school kids and their beautiful questions and profound insights on the world expressed in children's language with, as Jesus would say, "no guile or duplicity." I think of the beautiful Christmas party we had with the homeless people lodged in the hotel by the highway, the amazing work of the St. Vincent DePaul Society to keep true to their mission even when some would take advantage unfairly. The amazing work of the Knights, the Sodality, the St Joseph's Men's Guild, and the Commission to help our Brothers and Sisters, and the dedication of our school teachers come to mind. I am especially thankful for Alpha, peoples' openness to it has strengthened faith of many who have participated. I go thankful for the opportunity to have served you and conscious that God's providence is at work in your lives and in mine. Through the intercession of St. Monica, St. Lucy and most especially Our Lady, may God bless you today and always.


