FROM FR. BILL

Staffing of a parish – Always a challenge, always an opportunity to trust God

One of the biggest challenges to leading two parishes and a school is trying to make sure we have the right people in the right positions to carry out the mission of the Church. We know that life is always presenting us with changes and accepting changes when they come unexpectedly is an important life skill that I feel we never fully acquire with total confidence. For the Christian, we believe firmly in God's providence and that he knows the "big picture" that we can't always see so clearly because we are not Him. Around Labor Day we experienced a big loss when Fr. John Cassani took a leave of absence. So far we have not received a new priest to take his place but we are confident before long we will and continue to pray for one that will be a good fit. I am so grateful to the priests who have been filling in for us. This month we will see Fr. Richard O'Brien on each weekend rotating between the parishes. Fr. Joe Thomas, as always, plays a key role in keeping us going, even more so when we are shorthanded.

This week we said good-bye to our Director of Music, Paul Jernberg, who took a position closer to home for family reasons. It will be a challenge to replace such an accomplished musician but we are confident as we prepare to post the job, that many good directors will be interested in applying. Sharon Waning has been great in lining up fill-ins for now and we hope to hire after January 1st when musicians are more likely to be open to changing jobs. I greatly appreciate your patience with the interim situation at St. Monica especially on the few dates we may have no musical accompaniment. I appreciate the flexibility of those at St Lucy, as we ensure that the faith formation 9:30 Mass at each parish will always have an organist.

Lastly, but not to be overlooked, we also said good-bye at the end of the summer to Sammie Moore, Confirmation Coordinator and Youth Minister, who also took a job much closer to home. For now Karl Jackson is overseeing our confirmation program. We have made a strategic decision to hold off on hiring a new youth minister as part of a shift in focus. We are moving away from the youth minister model for now and putting a large investment into Alpha. It is our hope that as Alpha grows and our parishioners grow in discipleship that some will have an interest in forming a Core Team that will work with and mentor our youth. We are confident this long-term strategy will yield benefits that will be long lasting. Often parishes that rely only on a youth minister, even one as gifted as Sammie Moore, experience a large drop off in participation when the popular youth minister leaves. The youth programs in the archdiocese that have shown lasting fruit have successfully implemented a Core Team model. This does not preclude hiring a youth minister later, but the Core Team of parishioners will be the backbone of a good program in the future.

Please continue to pray that God will lead the right persons to these positions and that Alpha will continue to bring us closer to God and closer to one another.


