Everyone's Mother

Perhaps one of the greatest compliments a woman can receive is that those who are not her children in the natural order, consider her to be like a mother, or perhaps a second mother. No doubt teachers and religious sisters that made an impact in our lives come to mind, as we think of these second mothers. Perhaps as a child you had a friend's mom who always made you feel at home, inviting you and her own child's other friends in for a sandwich or soda during a break in a game of street hockey or whiffle ball on a hot summer day. In addition to loving our own moms, it is important to contemplate spiritual motherhood in these days of May, a month traditionally dedicated to Mary. That emphasis is even more amplified this year as we have just celebrated the 100th anniversary of Our Lady's first appearance at Fatima.

One of the greatest wonders of the Incarnation, is that in that moment of Jesus' conception within the womb of Mary, God himself had a mother. Mary bore her Son as one of the Eucharistic Prefaces tells us, "with a love beyond all telling". We marvel at the love that that Perfect Son and perfect mother share. As Catholics we know in firm faith that Jesus gave us His own mother to be ours when He commended her to Saint John the Evangelist's care as he hung upon the cross. "Son, behold your mother." How amazing that he would give us such a gift. This mother too, just like our earthly mothers, basks in the affection of her loving children. She does not compete with our earthly moms but raises their dignity as we see Mary, though in an imperfect way, in them. Do we take time to thank Mary for her "yes" to God's plan and for her acceptance of God's call to care for us just as she did Jesus? "Woman, behold your son." Mary, though unrelated to us by blood, is the greatest spiritual mom.

Those of us fortunate to have mom's still living on earth, joyfully made time for them last Sunday. Why would we not do the same for our heavenly mom?

This week for four nights, beginning tonight at St. Monica (Sunday through Wednesday). We have an opportunity to show our heavenly mother this love and devotion and to be reminded of her powerful presence in our lives. Fr. David Gunter, MIC who served for several years at St. Monica Parish, is returning to lead us in a parish mission called the "The Triumph". It is my sincere hope that many from both our parishes and beyond will participate. There is nothing like a mother's love. How blest we are to have her. May we remember her and travel to her just as lovingly and passionately as we did our earthly moms last Sunday. We will begin tonight (Sunday) at 7pm and Monday through Wednesday we will begin at 6:00pm with the rosary and confessions.


