





FROM FR. Cassani

In his first Encyclical letter, Deus Caritas Est, Pope Benedict XVI gave a wonderful reflection on the connection between faith and charity. "We have come to know and to believe in the love God has for us. (1 Jn 4:16)." He goes on to tell us that "being Christian is not the result of an ethical choice or a lofty idea, but the encounter with an event, a person... Since God has first loved us, love is now no longer a mere command; it is the response to the gift of love with which God draws near to us." It is not enough for us Christians to know about God, even if one were to be able to recite from memory every article of the Catechism! Lent is the time the Church sets aside so that we can tune our entire selves with our intellects, bodies and spirits moving closer to the love which God wishes to shower upon us.

Love is the standard for everything we do, especially during this season. Fasting allows our bodies to heed the words Christ spoke to Satan as he was tempted; "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God. (Mt. 4:4)" When our lives are ruled less by our appetites, and more by our mind and will, we are able to be more like Jesus. Almsgiving trains us to live as instruments of the love of God. How often have we experienced God's love? It is good for each of us to reflect on this often. For me, the love of God is manifest most often through the love that others have shown me. When the poor pray for relief, God answers their prayers in many ways, but certainly through what we give to the poor. Prayer is the most important form of love we can express this Lent. The conversation we have with God allows us to hear his will all the better, so that we can know clearly the way our lives must be shaped.

Let us pray for one another during this Lent, and encourage one another to sacrifice in such a way that we can come to love God with everything we have, and bring His love to everyone, especially those who need it most.
