
Program for Adults desiring to receive the Sacraments



FROM FR. BILL

Dying young- Loving those in our lives in the here and now, confident of God's care

Today I offered a funeral mass for a 52 year old life-long family friend in West Roxbury. Up until two years ago he was believed to be entirely healthy until a routine colon exam revealed an aggressive cancer that claimed his life. Jack had a beautiful wife, five great kids ranging from first grade to a sophomore at the US Airforce Academy. He came from a close and strong nuclear family and enjoyed the love and esteem of all his peers in the community. The wait to see his family at the wake was 90 minutes and the church was filled. Jack went to church, was a good husband and father and took good care of himself physically. His death by our estimate is unfair, and it is easy to be frustrated or even mad at God regarding his passing so young, with so much life, especially family life left to be lived. I write these words not to depress you, but rather that they could be a spark in your life to value the gift of time, the gift of health, if you are fortunate right now to enjoy it, and so that like Jack you will realize how important family and friends are. Sometimes we don't take accounting of these things in the ordinary flow of daily life, but how important that we love each other to the fullest each and every day. His family is supported by so many in the community because he was a gentle, caring and loving man who gave of himself wholeheartedly. Though he suffered terribly at the end of his life, he died in peace, knowing he had done his best for God, family and friends. May we look at our own lives and make the changes that may be necessary so that if we were called home we could go with the peace that he had.
