#### FROM THE PASTOR

If you are tempted to say: "Wow, Lent? Already?", then at least you can take some solace from the origin of the word "Lent." Supposedly, it is a bit of an abbreviation of the word "lengthening," which refers to the fact that the daylight is getting longer as we approach spring. Perhaps the arrival of Lent, then, could bring with it a motivation to embrace our spiritual practices with extra vigor as preparation for Easter and warmer weather.

One of my goals as pastor is to try to use the Collaborative arrangement of our parishes to enhance what is available to the parishioner. However, as I often say, this does not mean that we will robotically duplicate activities, but that we will look to what is available at **each** parish as a way to enhance the Faith life of everybody. The intention of incorporating some changes to our Lenten spiritual practices this year is to give more people an extra opportunity and motivation to participate. Perhaps the most dramatic change in this vain is to the daily Mass time at St. Monica's on Thursdays and Fridays. It is being moved to 8:15 during Lent to allow the St. Monica School kids to go to Mass at least once per week. However, a list of Masses in other local parishes has been made available in this bulletin for anyone who adds early morning Mass to their workday as a Lenten practice.

A better example of a change that I hope will allow greater participation has to do with our Station of the Cross times. We are blessed to have the Stations offered every Friday of Lent at each parish, but with the now earlier time for Friday Confessions and Benediction at St. Monica, an opportunity opens up to provide both a daytime and an evening offering for the Stations of which anyone in either parish can take advantage.

So with that in mind, St. Monica will offer Stations of the Cross at 2:30pm on the Fridays of Lent, which will align it more closely with the hour that Our Lord gave up his spirit on the Cross **and** allow more families and after schoolers to have exposure to this very important spiritual tradition of the Church. Similarly, because St. Lucy adds to its Stations the great option of a simple, meatless meal during the Fridays of Lent, the time for that is being moved to 6:00pm to allow more commuters and families to participate, irrespective of what parish any of us calls home.

Please refer to the lineup of Lenten spiritual practices included in this bulletin and make note of any change in time or location compared to previous years. I ask that you keep in mind the reasoning behind these changes if you find any of them inconvenient, which I acknowledge can in itself be an additional Lenten sacrifice. God bless you.




