<u>Changes in Mass Schedule- A difficult reality</u> <u>but a necessary change</u>

After consulting with the parish council I have decided to reduce the number of weekend obligatory masses in the collaborating parishes from nine to seven.

Presently at the parishes of St. Monica and St. Lucy nine Masses are offered each weekend for the Sunday obligation, which of course include the two 4:00 pm masses on Saturday. The mass counts recently taken this fall showed an average attendance of 650 a week at St Lucy and of those, 255 are attending on Saturday afternoon. This leaves 3 small Sunday Masses averaging only around 133 people. Even on weekends with religious formation for children, the church can easily accommodate the congregation with only two masses in the morning rather than three.

If more of us are together at fewer masses several important benefits are achieved. Firstly, people see more of each other and relationships are formed and deepened as people get to know each other better. Psychologically it is better not to experience the feeling of worshiping in a sparsely populated church. By having a larger crowd at Mass the congregational responses and the singing are greatly enhanced making for a healthier more powerful worship experience. We also can provide instrumental accompaniment at all the masses. The priest shortage is also a critical factor in reducing the number of weekend masses and as the shortage of priests in greater Boston grows more acute we must be certain the schedule is healthy for the priests. Remember that the priests are covering large numbers of funerals and also weddings and baptisms in addition to all of the other sacramental and administrative work they must do. important to remember the schedules we now have were implemented when there were more

priests serving in our parishes. At a time when we have so few, the importance of the wellbeing of the priests cannot be overstated.

The possibility of reducing the Sunday morning masses at St. Monica was also discussed at parish council. St. Monica has over 1,000 people coming most weekends and remains, as it has traditionally been, a much larger parish than St. Lucy, and with the size of its religious education program, and the relatively small parking lot, three morning Masses are still needed at St. Monica.

The 5:30 evening mass at St Monica during the recent mass counts averaged only 95 people, so we are going to discontinue that mass.

Next weekend at all Saint Lucy masses, the congregation will be polled as to whether they prefer a 9:00am and an 11:00am or an 8:00 and a 10:00. The council and I all agreed it would be better to have slight stagger in start times relative to St. Monica rather than exact overlap of start times we currently have for most masses. This way, if people of either parish miss their preferred mass on a given weekend they have an alternative start time only a short drive away right here in Methuen. After soliciting feedback we will discuss at the January parish council meeting which schedule we will adopt for Saint Lucy. I know that these changes will require many of the people at St Lucy, and some of those at St. Monica to change their current My hope is that it will be an mass time. opportunity to sacrifice a little bit convenience for the greater good and health of the parishes and its priests and I am deeply appreciative of your openness to these changes.

The new schedule will be effective the first Sunday of Lent.



Meet Father Cusack —


Embracing his vocation, embracing God's people
